<p>A-Team Administration</p>	<p>The A-Team uses the gift of administration to collect and maintain data for initial First Time Visitors' intake, as well as provide voluntary administrative support to the ministry.</p>
<p>Congregational Care</p>	<p>This team assists our Pastors and ministerial staff in supporting the members of Linked UP Church through phone calls, hospital visits, and home visits.</p>
<p>Connect Central</p>	<p>This team serves as our Linked UP Church Hot Spot/Bookstore, selling Linked UP merchandise and assisting with various church campaigns. They also assist as an information center for the church.</p>
<p>Connected Praise (Dance and Mime Ministry)</p>	<p>This team ministers through dance and mime during praise and worship, special services, church productions, and special events.</p> <p>Requirements: Dance Audition, Age 18+</p>
<p>Creative Arts</p>	<p>This team brings their creativity to minister during special services and productions They consist of Screenwriters, Actors, Directors, Acting Coaches, Make Up Artists, Hairstylists, and Wardrobe Stylists.</p>
<p>Hospitality</p>	<p>This energetic team connects with guests by offering a warm welcome, answering questions, escorting guests, and assisting with the First Time Visitors Reception. They are positioned at the outside entrance and throughout the hallways of the church.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;">Linked UP Worship (Band, Choir, Worship Team)</p>	<p>This dynamic team prepares the way for our guests to encounter the presence of the living God through vocals, instruments, and audio engineering.</p> <p>Requirements: Band & Worship Team Audition</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Little LinkLand</p>	<p>This team leads children into a real relationship with Jesus through Bible stories, worship, prayer, hands-on activities, and personal interactions.</p> <p>Serves children ages 4 months-3 years old</p> <p>Requirements: Background Check</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Ministry Room</p>	<p>This team ministers to individuals who respond to the altar call invitations of Salvation, Rededication, Membership, Baptism of the Holy Spirit, and Prayer, guiding respondents to a better understanding of how their lives can be improved through the knowledge of God's Word and a better relationship with Him.</p>

LEADERSHIP HONOR CODE

As an essential part of the Linked UP Church Leadership family, you have a responsibility to develop and exhibit mature Christian behavior. This is a fundamental expectation of those participating in a servant-leader position here at Linked UP Church.

While serving the Body of Christ as a servant-leader at Linked UP Church, you pledge to:

- **LOVE GOD (Psalm 24:3-4; Matthew 22:37)**
 - Commit yourself to spending time with the Lord daily in worship, Word, and prayer.
 - Be passionate about the presence of God and live a life that reflects the love of Christ.
 - Refrain from such things as:
 - profanity
 - smoking or chewing tobacco
 - gambling
 - indulging in much wine or other alcoholic beverages
 - dishonest gain
 - illegal drugs
 - pornography
 - sexual immorality
 - all behaviors which might cause Christ to grieve and others to stumble.

- **LOVE PEOPLE (Philippians 1:1-4)**
 - Have a genuine love for people: those we serve and those we serve with
 - Commit to growing relationally with your Dream Team (Heart > Gift/Ability)

- **PURSUE EXCELLENCE (Philippians 3:12-16)**
 - Continually develop the talents and gifts that God has given you
 - Welcome and embrace constructive feedback

- **CHOOSE JOY (Romans 15:13; Philippians 2:5-7a)**
 - Let the joy of the Lord be your overflow to others
 - Endeavor to have the mind of Christ
 - Approach life with an attitude of humility and an atmosphere of fun

By providing an example in speech and action, we encourage others to grow in Christ and become servant-leaders themselves. This is a way of life measured by the heart and commitment of each leader in the Linked UP Church family. Serving and leading others by example is a privilege (Numbers 18:7), not an imposition or restriction.

ABUSE POLICY

I understand that Linked UP Church is a safe place for children and vulnerable adults and that we comply with all Federal and State laws regarding reporting suspected child abuse. As a member of the Dream Team, I understand that suspected abuse is to be reported to the staff member who oversees the area in which I serve. I also understand the four types of abuse defined below:

- Physical: a physical act directed at a child or vulnerable adult that causes injury.
- Sexual: contact or interactions between a child and an adult, or another child, when the child is being used for sexual stimulation of the perpetrator or another person. This includes exploitation through photographs, videos, or other communication methods.
- Emotional: acts or omissions by the parent or other caregivers that have caused, or could cause, serious behavioral, cognitive, emotional, or mental disorders.
- Neglect: failure to provide for the child or vulnerable adult's basic needs. This includes adequate adult supervision, medical attention, housing, food, and clothing. Most cases of physical neglect involve inadequate adult supervision that has caused harm to the child or vulnerable adult or places them in danger of such harm.

I understand it is not my responsibility to investigate and in no instance will I confront a parent or caregiver if abuse is suspected. As a member of the Dream Team, I agree to comply with this policy and report any suspected abuse to the staff person who oversees the area in which I serve.


QUALIFICATIONS OF A DREAM TEAM MEMBER

QUESTIONS ABOUT TITHING

What is tithing?

“Tithe” means “a tenth part.”

What is the difference between a tithe and an offering?

A “tithe” is giving the first tenth of my income.

An “offering” is anything I give in addition to my tithe.

Why should I tithe?

Tithing reminds me that everything I have was given to me by God.

“Always remember that it is the Lord your God who gives you the ability to produce wealth.” Deuteronomy 8:18

Tithing demonstrates that God has first place in my life.

“And you shall eat before the Lord your God, in the place where He chooses to make His name abide, the tithe of your grain and your new wine and your oil, of the firstborn of your herds and your flocks, that you may learn to fear the Lord your God.” Deuteronomy 14:23

Tithing expresses my love to the Lord.

“Each of you should bring a gift in proportion to the way the Lord your God has blessed you.” Deuteronomy 16:17

What should I tithe?

The tithe should come from the first part of what I earn.

“Honor the Lord by giving him the first part of all your income.” Proverbs 3:9-10

Where should I give my Tithe?

The tithe should be given where I worship.

“Bring your whole tithe to My Storehouse (Temple).” Malachi 3:10

When should I Tithe?

The tithe should be given weekly.

“On the first day of every week let each one of you lay something aside, storing up as he may prosper, that there be no collections when I come.”

1 Corinthians 16:2
