LEADERSHIP HONOR CODE

As an essential part of the Linked UP Church Leadership family, you have a responsibility to develop and exhibit mature Christian behavior. This is a fundamental expectation of those participating in a servant-leader position here at Linked UP Church.

While serving the Body of Christ as a servant-leader at Linked UP Church, you pledge to:

LOVE GOD (Psalm 24:3-4; Matthew 22:37)

- Commit yourself to spending time with the Lord daily in worship, Word, and prayer.
- Be passionate about the presence of God and live a life that reflects the love of Christ.
 Refrain from such things as:
 - → profanity
 - → smoking or chewing tobacco
 - → gambling
 - → indulging in much wine or other alcoholic beverages
 - → dishonest gain
 - → illegal drugs
 - → pornography
 - → sexual immorality
 - all behaviors which might cause Christ to grieve and others to stumble.
- LOVE PEOPLE (Philippians 1:1-4) Have a genuine love for people: those we serve and those we serve with
 - Commit to growing relationally with your Dream Team (Heart > Gift/Ability)
- PURSUE EXCELLENCE (Philippians 3:12-16)
 - Continually develop the talents and gifts that God has given you
 Welcome and embrace constructive feedback
- CHOOSE JOY (Romans 15:13; Philippians 2:5-7a)
 - Let the joy of the Lord be your overflow to others o Endeavor to have the mind of Christ
 - Approach life with an attitude of humility and an atmosphere of fun

By providing an example in speech and action, we encourage others to grow in Christ and become servant-leaders themselves. This is a way of life measured by the heart and commitment of each leader in the Linked UP Church family. Serving and leading others by example is a privilege (Numbers 18:7), not an imposition or restriction.

ABUSE POLICY

I understand that Linked UP Church is a safe place for children and vulnerable adults and that we comply with all Federal and State laws regarding reporting suspected child abuse. As a member of the Dream Team, I understand that suspected abuse is to be reported to the staff member who oversees the area in which I serve. I also understand the four types of abuse defined below:

- Physical: a physical act directed at a child or vulnerable adult that causes injury.
- Sexual: contact or interactions between a child and an adult, or another child, when the child is being used for sexual stimulation of the perpetrator or another person. This includes exploitation through photographs, videos, or other communication methods.
- Emotional: acts or omissions by the parent or other caregivers that have caused, or could cause, serious behavioral, cognitive, emotional, or mental disorders.
- Neglect: failure to provide for the child or vulnerable adult's basic needs. This includes adequate adult supervision, medical attention, housing, food, and clothing. Most cases of physical neglect involve inadequate adult supervision that has caused harm to the child or vulnerable adult or places them in danger of such harm.

I understand it is not my responsibility to investigate and in no instance will I confront a parent or caregiver if abuse is suspected. As a member of the Dream Team, I agree to comply with this policy and report any suspected abuse to the staff person who oversees the area in which I serve.

QUALIFICATIONS OF A DREAM TEAM MEMBER

The same goes for those who want to be servants in the church: serious, not deceitful, not too free with the bottle, not in it for what they can get out of it. They must be reverent before the mystery of the faith, not using their position to try to run things. Let them prove themselves first. If they show they can do it, take them on. No exceptions are to be made for women—same qualifications: serious, dependable, not sharp-tongued, not overfond of wine. Servants in the church are to be committed to their spouses, attentive to their own children, and diligent in looking after their own affairs. Those who do this servant work will come to be highly respected, a real credit to this Jesusfaith. 1 Timothy 3:8-13 (MSG)

- 1. Be sincere, worthy of respect, and of good reputation
- 2. Tithe regularly to Linked UP Church
- 3. Have a genuine desire to serve and minister to other people
- 4. Able to lead motivate, and teach other people
- 5. Able to create positive group dynamics and resolve conflict within the group.

1. Find a Group

- Find a group by contacting the church office, visiting our website (www.linkedupchurch.com) or emailing connectgroups@linkedupchurch.com.
- Contact the leader.
- If you desire to lead a group, attend Connect Group Leader Orientation and get equipped to lead a group that you are passionate about.

2. Commit for a Semester at a Time

New groups start two semesters each year: Spring (February – May) and Fall (September – December). Most groups are open to new members throughout the semester.

3. Experience a Life Change

You'll never fully experience what Linked UP Church has to offer until you connect in a connect group! Connect groups were vital to the first century church's growth, and they are just as vital now.

Life is not meant to be lived alone. In fact, God hates loneliness. You were created to experience life with other people, and that's why at Linked UP Church, we encourage you to get into a connect group.

A connect group is a group of three or more people who gather weekly, biweekly, or monthly during Spring and Fall Semesters in a home, workplace, or online. In a group you'll hang out, study the Word, and pray together.
